CODE OF CONDUCT

The American Legion Auxiliary (ALA) Girls Nation and ALA Girls State is a youth serving, community-based organization dedicated to female high school students for civic leadership. Participation in the organization's program is subject to the observance of the American Legion Auxiliary rules and procedures. **The activities outlined below are strictly prohibited.** Any participant, staff member, or volunteer who violates this code is subject to discipline, up to and including removal from the program.

- Abusive language toward a staff member, volunteer, or fellow participant.
- Possession of or use of alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, tobacco products, and/or vapes during the program or reporting to the program while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Bringing to the ALA Girls State program dangerous property or unauthorized materials, such as explosives, firearms, weapons, or other similar items.
- Discourtesy or rudeness to a staff member, volunteer, or fellow participant.
- Verbal, physical, or visual harassment of a staff member, volunteer, or fellow participant.
- Actual or threatened violence toward any individual or group.
- Conduct endangering the life, safety, health, or wellbeing of others.
- Failure to follow the Girls State Rules and/or University of Nebraska-Lincoln policies (provided in the Girls State Packet)
- Bullying or sexual harassment of any participant.
- Failure to cooperate with directions from an adult supervisor/leader/mentor.
